The Campout will be based around the woolshed at Scottsdale. The woolshed will provide us with facilities to assemble and will give us all-weather protection. All Bird Call sessions will be held in the woolshed as will presentations on Wednesday evening and the quiz on Friday night.

Camping will occur around the woolshed and the surrounding area will be allocated to campers and those in caravans, mobile homes etc. A map of the various areas will be on show at the woolshed on arrival. Due to the layout of the site it will be necessary to impose a curfew on the use of generators. The timing of the curfew will be decided by the participants of the Campout at our first assembly. It is envisaged that those wishing to camp near their vehicles will be able to do so.

A Welcome Pack will be provided on arrival which will list contact numbers, camp rules, bird lists, maps etc. Note: sunrise will be at 6:20am and sunset at 5.51pm. Be prepared for cold early mornings.
